AFTER 13 YEARS





✓ In June 2022, the Delhi High Court overturned a 2010 MCI order.

✓ A radiologist had been temporarily suspended by the Medical Council of India (MCI) for alleged falsification of medical records.





⤵ MCI's original ruling was based on accusations of falsifying medical records.

⤵ The doctor's name was temporarily removed from the medical registry.

- Justice C. Hari Shankar ruled in favor of the radiologist, stating there was no evidence of medical negligence.
- Falsification claims, which were never part of the original charges, were acknowledged by MCI but lacked substantiation.





✓ The Delhi High Court's verdict sets a significant precedent in medico-legal cases.

✓ It emphasizes the importance of solid evidence when making allegations against medical professionals.





✓ MCI's unsubstantiated claims were effectively overturned.

✓ The case highlights the necessity for fairness and due process in disciplinary actions against doctors.





After 13 years, the radiologist was cleared, restoring his professional dignity.

This case underscores the critical need for evidence-based decisions in medical legal matters.
